

Resolution for Consideration of the 2016 Triennial Meeting
The Canadian Fellowship of Baden-Powell Guilds

Whereas:

The current Policy and Procedures states:

Uniforms

There is no 'official' Baden-Powell Guild uniform. When uniformity is required, Baden-Powell Guilds may suggest that members wear a similar piece of clothing that is suitable for Baden-Powell Guild activities and on which is placed the Canadian Fellowship of Baden-Powell Guild's badge. Suggested dress for formal occasions is as follows: a light blue shirt, navy blue blazer (with the regular official Canadian Fellowship of Baden-Powell Guild's badge on the left breast pocket), a navy blue tie and gray slacks or skirt. If so desired, the official neckerchief as designed by the Canadian Fellowship of Baden-Powell Guilds and offered in a kit, can be obtained by a Baden-Powell Guild member and added to these uniforms (the official colours are navy blue with a narrow red border).

Therefore be it resolved "The following be inserted into Section 14 of the Constitution and Section 14 be retitled "Emblem, Flag and Uniform"

Uniforms

The official uniform of the Canadian Baden-Powell Guild uniform shall be a light blue shirt, navy blue blazer (with the regular official three inch Canadian Fellowship of Baden-Powell Guild's crest on the left breast pocket), a navy blue tie and gray slacks or skirt. If so desired, the official neckerchief as designed by the Canadian Fellowship of Baden-Powell Guild can replace the navy blue tie.

When uniformity is required for Guild activities, Baden-Powell Guilds may suggest that members wear a similar piece of clothing that is suitable for the Guild activity, on which is placed the Canadian Fellowship of Baden-Powell Guild's crest.
